POOL DIRECTOR

The new gate is up and working at the pool. We have had some small expenses with the pump. There have been some problems with umbrellas blowing in the wind, and this has hopefully been corrected. There have been some complaints about both food and drink IN the pool, not just the pool area. This is NOT allowed, nor are glass bottles allowed in the pool or pool area. These rules are for the safety of everyone.

TENNIS DIRECTOR

We have gotten a quote for repairing existing cracks on the courts. The quote is about \$1600 for repair. We may be wise to wait until next spring to see how winter treats them. If repaired as they are, the cracks could reappear within 2 years. The light in the lower court needs to be fixed. All residents need to be reminded that the courts are for TENNIS ONLY. Residents should not walk dogs on our tennis courts!

DEVELOPMENT DIRECTOR

Triple A, our new landscape company, has done a nice
job with the flowers at the front of the neighborhood.

While they are less expensive than our previous
landscaper, and they do good work, the board has had
to stay on top of them to be sure that maintenance is
done as needed and all issues are addressed. We need
to examine our options for a new natural canopy along
the main drive to replace the existing maples which
are dying. We are not planning any new landscaping in
the pool area.

PRESIDENT

New board members, Dan Klar (pool) and Carol Gordon
(secretary) were introduced. The Social chair, Allie

Burns, was recognized for her hard work in making the 4th
of July activities a complete success. Last year's
financial challenges with regard to landscaping and
irrigation were discussed. We are in hopes that we are
now successfully moving beyond these issues. We know we
will be facing new challenges shortly with our aging fences
and needed clubhouse repairs. We expect to have ongoing
expenses with pool and upkeep of the tennis courts.

The now ongoing problem of speeding within the neighborhood

Karen Gratton is looking into the Gwinnett County Residential Speed Control Program (speed tables) which is an option we have for controlling speed in our neighborhood. If this is put to a vote, it requires approval of 70% of affected residents. In addition, each resident of the street where tables are placed would be taxed an additional \$12 per year. We discussed possible other options of speed control (flashing speed sign, sidewalk addition, additional STOP signs, reflectors, rumble strips, and asking our security patrol to issue speeding tickets). Karen will look into conducting a speed survey and a bike safety clinic for both kids and adults.
